Supplementary Examination (Online) for Examinees Unable to be Present  
Due to the New Coronavirus COVID-19  
(Graduate School Entrance Examinations (February) for Academic Year 2021)

Supplementary examinations will be held online as a special provision for examinees for the February entrance examinations that are unable to be present at the examination venue due to the effect of COVID-19, etc.

Those examinees must obtain authorization by submitting an “[Supplementary Examination Application Form](#)” to the contact desk for their program (place for submission of application documents).

Note that the date and method, etc., for the supplementary examinations will be set for each program, so examinees must check a [separate table](#).

Supplementary Examination Application Period

◆February Entrance Examinations December 1 (Tue) to January 20 (Wed)

However, even after the above application periods, if circumstances change suddenly, it may be possible to apply anytime (up to the day of the test)

Note that telephone calls will be accepted up until 10:00 am on the examination day.
